Course: Introduction to Forex

Course overview

This course aims to describe and explain the Basics of the Foreign Exchange (Forex) market. It explains the different Forex terminologies and aims to describe the Forex trading, who are the participants in the Forex market, what a currency pair is and the different advantages of the Forex market. It also aims to describe the different "Orders" and Trader's "Positions" (i.e. short, long, open, close, etc). It also explains the main fundamental drivers of exchange rates and provides examples for them.

Course Description

This course explains what the Foreign Exchange trade is. Forex is a global, international market which connects individuals, banks, and other financial institutions around the world to facilitate the exchange of currencies. It describes in summary the trading sessions and the participants in the Forex market and the different major and minor currency pairs. It also describes the different terminologies that are used in the Forex trading and explains in brief the different "Orders" and Trader's "Positions" (i.e. short, long, open, close, etc), as well as the main fundamental drivers of exchange rates.
